

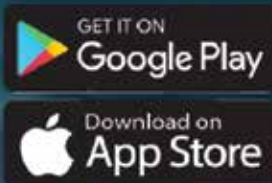

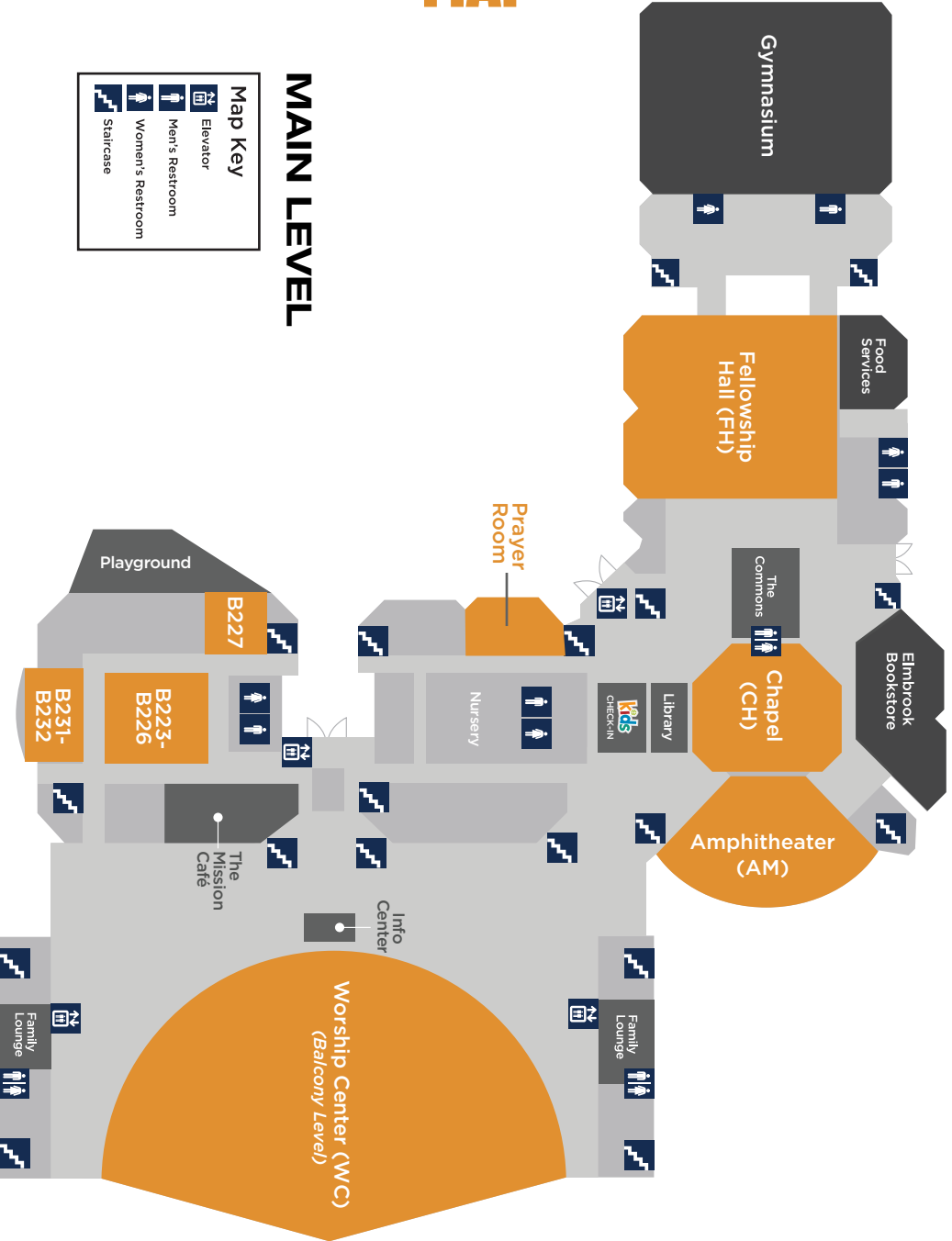


MAP

Map Key

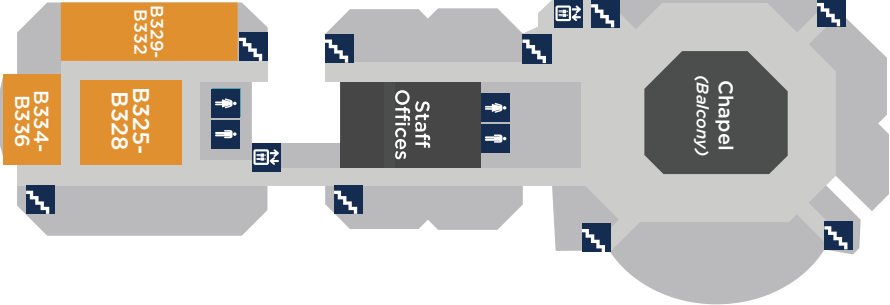
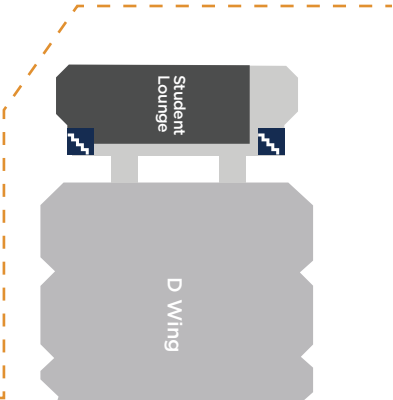
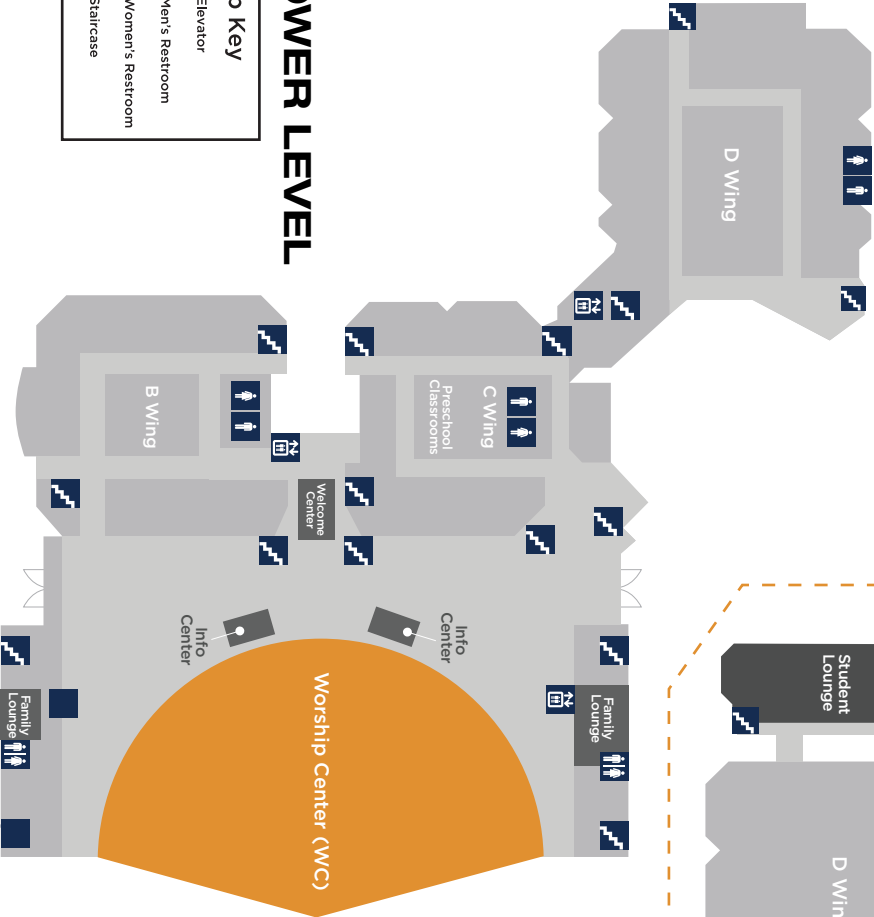
